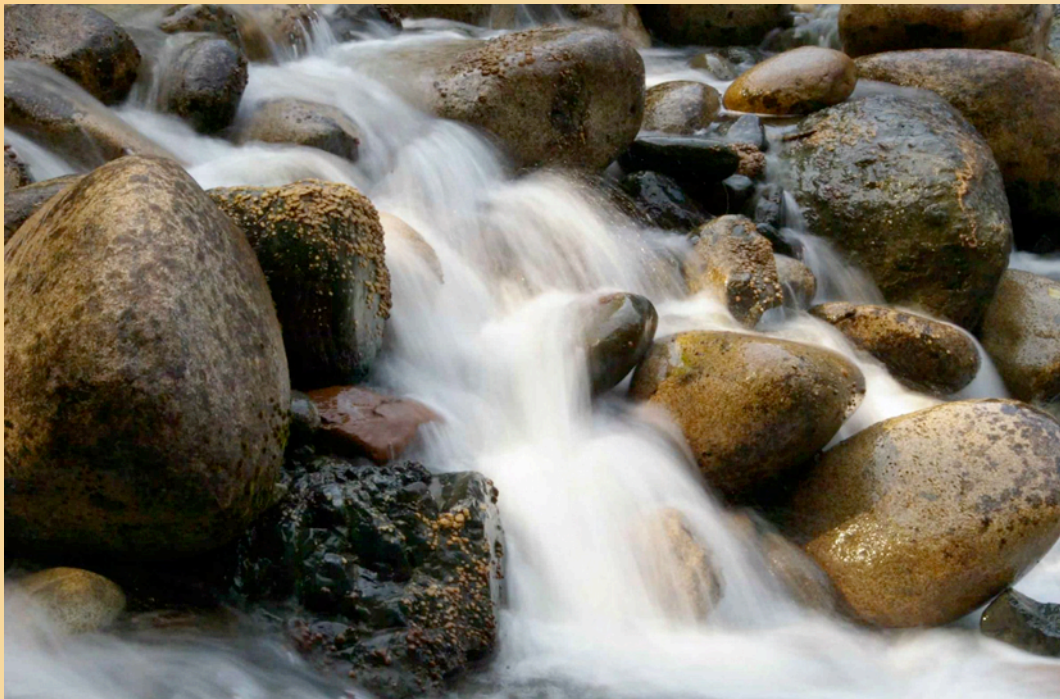

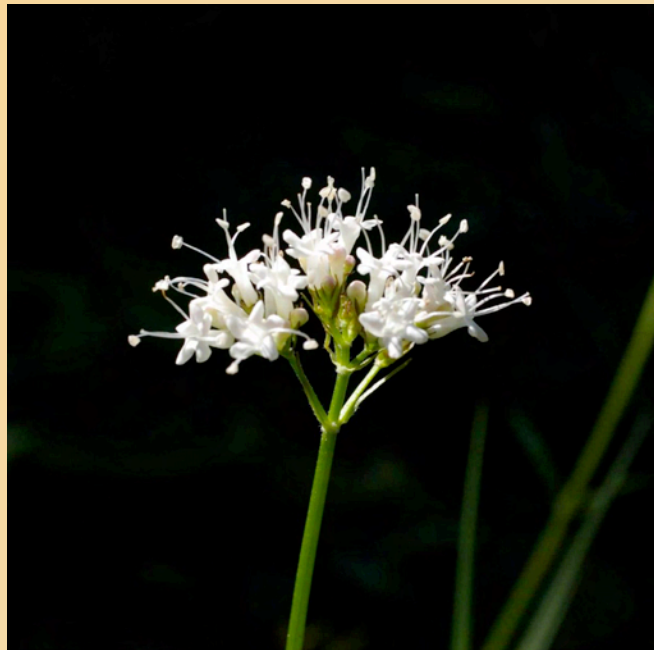

New Advertising Policy

The Board has received frequent requests to advertise in the newsletter, through our email broadcasts, or through posters at lectures. In the past this issue has been problematic as the Board has to ensure that the advertising material is appropriate to the mission of the Society, as well as not being perceived as sponsored by the Society. At the first Board meeting of this season, an advertising policy was established.

For all future advertising through the C.G. Jung Society:

Advertisers are welcome to submit their material to the Board at least one month prior to publication of the newsletter. The advertising has to be reviewed at a Board Meeting of the Society. The decision of the Board is final. (please contact any member of the Board to determine when our ne3xt Board Meeting is to be held. These dates have been set until June 2007).

The advertising must have a direct relevance to Jungian issues. The presenter/facilitator must be a licensed member of a regulatory body (provincial or federal).

Advertising costs \$50.00 (per insert into the newsletter, or email broadcast or poster distribution.)

Posters distributed at Society events, such as lectures, must be provided to the Board in time for the Board meeting immediately prior to the targeted event.

The Board will distribute posters at lectures.

The Celtic Heritage is best expressed in those stories concerning the relationship of king and goddess. The myths connected with this powerful theme not only were a source of inspiration for Arthurian legend of the Middle Ages, but also were a decisive influence on 19th century Irish literature which in turn sparked the war of independence. By means of narrative I will trace the various transformations of the Celtic heritage, ending with examples of its survival in contemporary Irish poetry. If time permits, I will end the talk with slides on Celtic landscapes and Celtic art.

In this workshop, individuals will first “birth” their mask by having a plaster cast made of their face. Participants will then enter into a process with their mask, initially through painting it and bringing the symbolic energy of the mask to life, followed by interacting with it through a series of dialogue exercises.

The intent of the workshop is to facilitate an experience whereby individuals actively come to know and interact with aspects of their persona and shadow. Participants who have attended this workshop have stated that they found it to be very empowering.



The emphasis of the workshop will be for the individual to gain personal insight, however, some sharing will be done amongst group members. Participants share only as much of their experience as they choose. Confidentiality is strictly adhered to in order to provide a safe container in which to explore the archetypes that come into play through working with the symbol of the mask.
